RULES FOR GUIDANCE OF THE CANDIDATE

- 1. The examination will be held according to the programme as notified.
- Candidates should report to the examination hall before half an hour of the scheduled time of starting of the examination and will not be allowed to leave the hall before completion of the examination.
- Candidates shall bring their respective Admit Card and the University Registration Certificate everyday of the Examination and shall produce them for verification, whenever required. Candidates will not be allowed to sit for the examination if he/she fail to produce the Admit Card.
- 4. Candidates suffering from any form of contagious or infectious diseases, or from any illness or disease considered to be prejudicial to the general body of students under examination, will not be admitted into or allowed to remain in the Examination Hall. Special arrangements will however be made for candidates who are suffering from certain categories of diseases if application is made to the Officer-in-Charge with sufficient notice
- 5. Before entering the Examination Hall candidates must deposit books, notes or other incriminating materials at a place set aside for the purpose which are forbidden for candidates to have in their possession. Such articles may be left there only at the candidate's own risk.
- 6. Communication of any sort or in any form is strictly forbidden between candidates or with other persons whether inside or outside the Examination Hall.
- 7. Candidates are required to sign their names and prove their identity as and when required to do so.
- 8. Candidates shall use main answer books supplied by the University. The answer books should be properly filled in by the candidates.
- Candidates must not write their names, names of the colleges or any other things which may disclose their identity on any page of the answer books. Candidates must not write any objectionable or improper remarks in their answer books.
- 10. Candidates must not write anything on any question paper or other paper, or carry away any writing or scribblings from the Examination
- 11. No Candidate shall be allowed to finally leave the Examination Hall without submitting the answer book. No candidate shall be allowed to re-enter the Examination Hall during the hours of the examination once leaving it after submission of the answer book.
- 12. A warning bell will be rung 10 minutes before the end of examination and the final bell will be rung at the close of examination.
- 13. At the close of the examination a candidate must remain seated until his/her answer book is collected by the invigilator.
- 14. Candidates are warned against any attempt to adopt unfair means at the examination. Any breach or attempted breach of any of these or other examination rules will render them liable to expulsion and to any other penalty as the University may deem fit. The decision of the University in all such cases shall be final. The Centre-In-Charge is requested to pack the Answer Scripts of RA Candidates separately with a forwarding letter along with the evidences of unfair means and the note of Centre-In-Charge and the Observer.
- 15. No electronic gadget including mobile phones, camera, calculator, electronic watch, etc. will be allowed within the examination hall.
- 16. The Centre-In-Charge and the invigilators will put their facsimile or sign respectively at the specified spaces of the Answer Scripts. No Stamp or Code Number of the College will be put on Answer Scripts.
- 17. No loose sheets will be provided to the candidates.
- 18. Centimetre graph papers and other required documents will be provided by the Centre if necessary.
- 19. No outsiders to be allowed in the examination centre premises.
